Helping Manufacturers Respond to COVID-19 Act of 2020

This bill authorizes the Department of Commerce to use amounts appropriated for the Hollings Manufacturing Extension Partnership program for FY2021 to provide more than 50% of the capital and annual operating and maintenance funds to establish and support a manufacturing extension center that is unable to meet cost share requirements due to COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019). Under current law, this provision of funding is capped at 50%.

A manufacturing extension center works to transfer manufacturing technology and best business practices.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 15, 2020:** Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation. Reported by Senator Wicker with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. Without written report.
- **Dec 15, 2020:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 641.
- **Nov 18, 2020:** Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation. Ordered to be reported with an amendment favorably.
- **Sep 24, 2020:** Introduced in Senate
- **Sep 24, 2020:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation.
