Firearm Lockbox Protection Act of 2019

This bill allows the General Services Administration, upon request of the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, to provide a secure firearms storage facility at the official duty station of each judge or justice for any lawfully possessed firearm by the judge or justice. Agencies that employ an administrative judge must provide a secure firearms facility at the principal duty station of that judge for any lawfully possessed firearm by the judge.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Oct 23, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 23, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
