Summary (as of Oct 23, 2019)

Break the Cycle of Violence Act

This bill authorizes new grant programs to support violence intervention initiatives.

Specifically, the Bureau of Justice Assistance must award grants for coordinated violence reduction initiatives in units of local government that are disproportionately impacted by gun and group-related violence.

Additionally, the National Institutes of Health must award grants for hospital-based violence intervention programs that reduce the risk of violent injury and retaliation among high-risk patients.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Oct 26, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Oct 23, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 23, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
