#### Joint Counterterrorism Assessment Team Authorization Act or the JCAT Authorization Act

This bill reauthorizes for FY2020-FY2025 the Interagency Threat Assessment and Coordination Group and renames the group the Joint Counterterrorism Assessment Team.

### Actions Timeline

- **Nov 14, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Intelligence and Counterterrorism.
- **Oct 28, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 28, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Intelligence (Permanent Select), and in addition to the Committee on Homeland Security, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
