Summary (as of Oct 29, 2019)

Public Safety Retirees Healthcare Protection Act

This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to increase from \$3,000 to \$6,000 the amount excludable from the gross income of public safety officers for distributions from governmental retirement plans for health and long-term care insurance.
