Summary (as of Oct 30, 2019)

Wounded Veterans Recreation Act

This bill instructs the Department of the Interior and the Department of Agriculture to make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available, without charge and for the lifetime of the passholder, to any veteran who has been found to have a compensable or noncompensable service-connected disability.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Nov 14, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Oct 30, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 30, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
