### Summary (as of Nov 1, 2019)

#### Trusting Commercial Communications Networks Act of 2019

This bill requires the Federal Communications Commission to publish a list of communications equipment or services that pose a national security risk and forbids federal funds from being used to purchase such equipment or services.

## Actions Timeline

- **Nov 4, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology.
- **Nov 1, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 1, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
