### Summary (as of Nov 13, 2019)

#### Troops Educating And Managing Schools Act or the TEAMS Act

This bill renames the Troops-to-Teachers Program as the Veterans-to-Classrooms Program, expands the program to include recruitment of veterans to non-teaching positions such as positions for nurses, counselors, and school resource officers, and generally modifies the program's scope and related requirements.

- **Nov 13, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 13, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on Education and Labor, the Judiciary, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
