Summary (as of Nov 14, 2019)

Growing Renewable Energy through Existing and New Environmentally Responsible Fuels Act or the GREENER Fuels Act

This bill revises the renewable fuel program, including to eliminate the volume standards applicable to corn-starch ethanol and extend the volume standards applicable to cellulosic biofuel.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 26, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Nov 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **Nov 14, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 14, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
