Summary (as of Nov 18, 2019)

Transparency in Government Act of 2019

This bill establishes reporting, disclosure, and other requirements across all branches of government to expand public access to information such as federal spending, Supreme Court proceedings, and White House visitor access records.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 18, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Courts, Intellectual Property, and the Internet.
- **Nov 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committees on Rules, House Administration, the Judiciary, Ethics, Financial Services, and the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
