Res. 519, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Cole demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until later in the legislative day.

- **Jul 24, 2019:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 116-183, by Mr. Perlmutter.
- **Jul 24, 2019:** Resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 3877 and H.R. 549 under closed rules. Resolution also waives clause 6(a) of Rule XIII, requiring a two-thirds vote waiver to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee against any resolution reported through the legislative day of July 26, 2019.
- **Jul 24, 2019:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 39.
