Summary (as of Nov 20, 2019)

Know Where to Go in an Emergency Act of 2019

This bill requires private health insurance plans to identify on insurance membership cards the in-network hospital or urgent care facility nearest to the primary residence of the plan holder.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 21, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 20, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 20, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
