Summary (as of Nov 21, 2019)

Extend Act

This bill extends for two years the temporary scheduling order issued by the Drug Enforcement Administration to place fentanyl-related substances in schedule I of the Controlled Substances Act. The temporary order expires on February 6, 2020.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 19, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Nov 22, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 21, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 21, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
