Among other things, the task force must study and make recommendations to reduce violence against and involving law enforcement and first responders.

### **Actions Timeline**

- **Dec 19, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Nov 25, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Nov 22, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 22, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
