Summary (as of Dec 4, 2019)

This bill modifies the criminal prohibition on possession of a firearm in a school zone.

Specifically, it revises an exception to permit an individual to possess a firearm in a school zone if that individual is in compliance with the laws of the state and political subdivision in which the school zone is located.
