## Summary (as of Dec 16, 2019)

### Lowest Price for Patients Act

This bill requires pharmacies to disclose to consumers when dispensing a prescription drug (1) the cost of the drug under the consumer's insurance plan, and (2) the cost of the drug without using their plan.

## Actions Timeline

- **Dec 17, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Dec 16, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 16, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
