Summary (as of Feb 21, 2020)

DHS Cybersecurity On-the-Job Training and Employment Apprenticeship Program Act

This bill requires the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to establish a DHS Cybersecurity On-the-Job Training and Employment Apprenticeship Program to identify and train DHS employees for cybersecurity work.

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency within DHS must lead the program. Among other things, the agency must (1) track the status of cybersecurity positions at DHS, (2) develop a program curriculum, and (3) recruit DHS employees for the program.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 6, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Infrastructure Protection, and Innovation.
- **Feb 21, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 21, 2020:** Referred to the House Committee on Homeland Security.
