Summary (as of Feb 28, 2020)

American Wild Game and Livestock Protection Act

This bill requires the Department of the Interior to issue as a final rule the proposed rule titled *Endangered and Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Removing the Gray Wolf (Canis lupus) From the List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife*.

This bill exempts the rule from judicial review.

- **Feb 28, 2020:** Referred to the House Committee on Natural Resources.
