Summary (as of Mar 2, 2020)

Veterans Burial Benefit Correction Act

This bill requires the Department of Veterans Affairs to provide an outer burial receptacle (i.e., a container for a casket) for new graves in cemeteries funded by a grant to a state or a tribal organization under the Veterans Cemetery Grants Program.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 10, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Mar 2, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 2, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
