## Summary (as of Mar 11, 2020)

### Medication Access in Emergencies Act of 2020

This bill requires private health insurance plans that cover prescription drugs to waive time restrictions on authorized refills as necessary to permit a plan holder to obtain a 30-day supply of a prescribed drug during a public health emergency.
