Interagency Council on Homelessness Coronavirus Guidance Act of 2020

This bill requires the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness to issue public guidance to stakeholders and other affected parties on best practices for preparing for, preventing, containing, and responding to COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019), including specifically for vulnerable homeless populations.
