Summary (as of Mar 23, 2020)

Increasing Hospital Capacity to Fight the Coronavirus Act of 2020

This bill allows unapproved capital expenses that are made by health care facilities during the public health emergency declared on January 31, 2020, relating to COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019) to be included in federal payment determinations under Medicare and Medicaid.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 23, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 23, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Mar 23, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
