This resolution sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 4617 (Stopping Harmful Interference in Elections for a Lasting Democracy Act or the SHIELD Act).

- **Oct 23, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 650.

Mr. Cole demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until a time to be announced.
