Summary (as of May 1, 2020)

Obstructing Monetary Allocations to Relatives Act or the OMAR Act

This bill prohibits a candidate for election to federal office from using amounts contributed to the candidate's campaign to make payments to vendors owned or controlled by an immediate family member of the candidate.
