Summary (as of May 12, 2020)

Emergency Limitation Periods Extensions for Workers Act

This bill extends the limitation period for filing specified claims or complaints under federal labor or employment laws that overlap with the COVID-19 (i.e., coronavirus disease 2019) public health emergency. For such an overlap, the filing limitation period is extended for 90 days beginning on the date after the public health emergency ends plus the number of days of overlap between the initial limitation period and the public health emergency.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 13, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations.
- **May 12, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **May 12, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, Veterans' Affairs, Oversight and Reform, and House Administration, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
