Summary (as of Jan 18, 2019)

Proven Wildfire Reduction Techniques Act of 2019

This bill authorizes the Department of Agriculture, for National Forest System lands, and the Department of the Interior, for public lands, to carry out insect and disease treatment programs in qualified forests (i.e., forests located in National Forest System lands or public lands) that meet the criteria specified under the Healthy Forests Restoration Act of 2003.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 8, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Feb 7, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Jan 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
