Summary (as of May 19, 2020)

Hong Kong Freedom Act

This bill authorizes the President to recognize Hong Kong as a separate and independent country from China. (Hong Kong is part of China but has a largely separate legal and economic system.)

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Asia, the Pacific and Nonproliferation.
- **May 19, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **May 19, 2020:** Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs.
