Summary (as of May 28, 2020)

This bill directs the Department of Health and Human Services to award through FY2024 additional funds to the Indian Health Service Sanitation Facilities Construction Program. This program provides American Indian and Alaska Native homes and communities with water supply, sewage disposal, and solid waste disposal facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 22, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States.
- **May 28, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **May 28, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
