Federal Broadband Deployment in Unserved Areas Act

This bill establishes measures to facilitate the sharing of broadband availability data among federal agencies to support the deployment of broadband in unserved areas.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 13, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jul 21, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Jun 25, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 25, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
