Ohio River Basin Preparedness Act

This bill requires the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to develop, implement, and publish an interagency plan for assisting states, Indian tribes, and communities in the Ohio River Basin to prepare for, and respond to, the effects of climate change.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 24, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Jul 24, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States.
- **Jul 1, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jun 30, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 30, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Financial Services, Agriculture, and Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
