## Summary (as of Jul 1, 2020)

### Equitable Payments for Nursing Facilities Act of 2020

This bill allows the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to adjust the federal per diem payment rate for Medicare skilled nursing facilities in Alaska or Hawaii to reflect the unique circumstances of such facilities.

## Actions Timeline

---

- **Jul 1, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 1, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jul 1, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 1, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
