Promoting Local Arts and Creative Economy Workforce Act of 2020 or the PLACE Act

This bill establishes or amends programs and activities to provide for opportunities for education or job training in a creative industry or occupation.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 30, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **Sep 11, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition, Oversight, and Department Operations.
- **Jul 6, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Jul 2, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 2, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, Financial Services, the Judiciary, Veterans' Affairs, Small Business, Ways and Means, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
