Streamlining Energy Efficiency for Schools Act

This bill directs the Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy to act as the lead agency for coordinating and disseminating information on existing programs and assistance that may be used to help initiate, develop, and finance energy efficiency, renewable energy, and energy retrofitting projects for schools.

- **Sep 19, 2019:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 208.
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Mar 6, 2019:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
- **Mar 5, 2019:** Mr. Tonko moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Mar 5, 2019:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H2328-2329)
- **Mar 5, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 762.
