### Summary (as of Jul 20, 2020)

#### Military Mental Health Stigma Reduction Act

This bill requires the Department of Defense, as part of required reports concerning suicide among members of the Armed Forces, to include a description of military programs that address and reduce the stigma associated with seeking assistance for mental health or suicidal thoughts.
