Actions Timeline

- **Jan 14, 2020:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR H215)
- **Jan 9, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 9, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
