Homeless Veterans Assistance Fund Act of 2020

This bill allows taxpayers to contribute tax refund amounts to a Homeless Veterans Assistance Fund established by this bill. The fund shall make expenditures to provide services to homeless veterans through the development and implementation of new and innovative strategies to prevent and end veteran homelessness.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 6, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **Oct 6, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 30, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Select Revenue Measures.
- **Jul 29, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 29, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
