## **Lori Jackson Domestic Violence Survivor Protection Act**

This bill amends the federal criminal code to modify the prohibition on firearm sale or transfer to, or purchase or possession by, an individual who is subject to a court order that restrains the individual from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner or child of an intimate partner. Specifically, the bill revises the elements of a qualifying court order. It also broadens the definitions of *intimate partner* and *misdemeanor crimes of domestic violence*.
