Summary (as of Jan 15, 2020)

This resolution (1) appoints Representatives Schiff, Nadler, Lofgren, Jeffries, Demings, Crow, and Garcia of Texas as managers to conduct the impeachment trial against the President; (2) requires the Senate to be informed of the appointment; and (3) authorizes the managers to exhibit the articles of impeachment to the Senate and take other necessary actions.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 15, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 15, 2020:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 767. (consideration: CR H252-258)
- **Jan 15, 2020:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Res. 755 with 6 hours of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions. Bill is closed to amendments. The question of adoption of the resolution, as amended shall be divided between the two articles. The amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted After adoption of H. Res. 755, it shall be in order without intervention of any point of order to consider in the House a resolution appointing and authorizing managers for the impeachment trial if offered by the chair of the Committee on the Judiciary or his designee.
- **Jan 15, 2020:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with ten minutes of debate on H. Res. 798.
- **Jan 15, 2020:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- **Jan 15, 2020:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 228 - 193 (Roll no. 18).
- **Jan 15, 2020:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 228 - 193 (Roll no. 18). (text: CR H252)
