Summary (as of Jan 15, 2020)

This resolution (1) supports preserving Vietnamese-American history and heritage, (2) recognizes the U.S. Refugee Admission Program for facilitating entry into the United States and permanent status for many Vietnamese Americans, and (3) condemns human rights violations by Vietnam and calls on that government to end such violations.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 28, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties.
- **Jan 15, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 15, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
