### Veterans Health Care Stamp Act

This bill requires the U.S. Postal Service to issue and sell a Veterans Health Care Stamp to help fund the medical care and treatment of veterans.

### Actions Timeline

- **Oct 6, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations.
- **Aug 21, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 21, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
