Summary (as of Jan 28, 2019)

This bill provides a bonus to federal employees who were excepted from furlough and worked without pay during the lapse in FY2019 appropriations that began on December 22, 2018. For each day that an employee worked without pay, the bill provides a bonus equal to 15% of the employee's daily rate of pay.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 29, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jan 28, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 28, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
