Summary (as of Jan 28, 2019)

Gun Show Loophole Closing Act of 2019

This bill establishes new requirements regarding firearm transfers at gun shows.

Specifically, the bill requires the following:

- a person who operates a gun show must meet certain requirements (e.g., minimum age and registration); and
- a firearm transfer between private parties at a gun show must be facilitated by a licensed gun dealer, importer, or manufacturer in compliance with certain background check and recordkeeping requirements.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 25, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Jan 28, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 28, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
