Human Trafficking Council Extension Act of 2020

This bill delays the termination of the Public-Private Partnership Advisory Council to End Human Trafficking until September 30, 2021.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 9, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Africa, Global Health, Global Human Rights, and International Organizations.
- **Sep 24, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 24, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
