Promoting Careers in Aviation for America's Veterans Act of 2020

This bill modifies the treatment of reimbursed flight training expenses for tax deduction purposes and in relation to educational assistance benefits for veterans.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 2, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Oct 1, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 1, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
