Summary (as of Oct 2, 2020)

Law Enforcement Officer Recreation Pass Act

This bill directs the Department of Agriculture and the Department of the Interior to make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available, without charge and for the lifetime of the passholder, to law enforcement officers.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 3, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Oct 2, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 2, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
