Pandemic Essential Supplies Act

This bill requires the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to establish an online system for states and local governments to submit requests for essential items during a disaster or emergency. It also designates the Director of the DLA as the head of an existing COVID-19 Joint Acquisition Task Force.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 13, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Oct 9, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 9, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
