Summary (as of Oct 20, 2020)

Organizational Fee Fairness Act

This bill revises the annual land use fee for organizational camps for their occupancy and use of National Forest System lands in counties in which less than 2% of land is used for farming.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 3, 2020:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Oct 20, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Oct 20, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
