Veterans Community Care Fairness Act

This bill requires covered veterans to submit a notification of the care or services they received within 30 days of being admitted for emergency care under the Veterans Community Care Program as a condition for authorization of such care by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). *Covered veterans* are those who are enrolled in the VA health care system or those who are not enrolled but are eligible for care due to a service-connected disability.
