Summary (as of Dec 3, 2020)

Badr Organization Designation Act of 2020

This bill prohibits the use of federal funds to support the Badr Organization, and it requires the Department of State to determine whether the organization meets criteria for (1) designation as a foreign terrorist organization, and (2) the imposition of certain sanctions. The Badr Organization is an Iran-based political party and the military arm of the Supreme Council for the Islamic Revolution in Iraq.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 21, 2020:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E1193)
- **Dec 3, 2020:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 3, 2020:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
