Summary (as of Dec 3, 2020)

Twenty-nine Palms Outdoor Recreational Enhancement Act

This bill directs the Department of the Interior to convey, without consideration, to the city of Twenty-nine Palms in California, at its request, all right, title, and interest of the United States in and to the surface estate of the land generally identified as *Proposed Conveyance to Twenty-nine Palms*. Such conveyance must occur not later than five years after the enactment of this bill.

The conveyed land may be used by the city to provide (1) a suitable location for the establishment of a centralized off-road vehicle recreation park, (2) the public with opportunities for off-road vehicle recreation, and (3) a designated area and facilities that will discourage unauthorized use of off-highway vehicles in areas containing environmentally sensitive land.
